A trip on the safari vehicle with a trained guide will take you into the bushveld where you will see zebra, giraffe, and various other plains antelope. After the 8km back trail, you are then driven past our hyena and cheetah camps before visiting our four lion camps, always learning interesting and amazing facts about the wildlife indigenous to Africa.

## LION PARK FEES

### Entrance Fee

Allows you to drive through the antelope comp, past the hyena and cheetah camps and through the four lion camps.

The fee also includes entrance into the popular Cub World where you can go in the cub enclosures to physically play with the cubs and take photographs

### Guided Game Drives

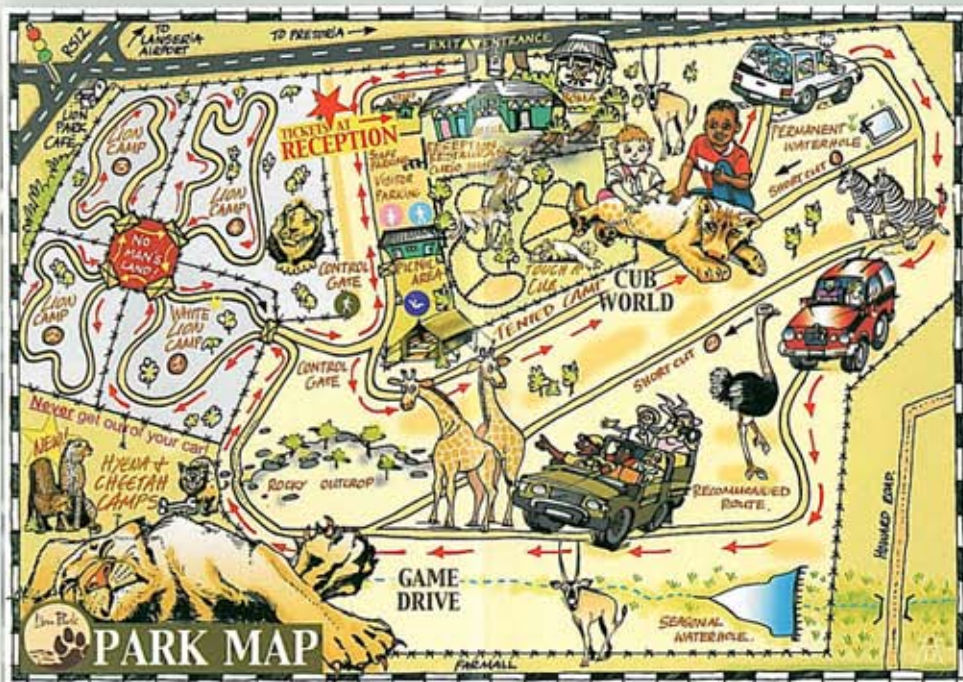
Enjoy a full tour of the entire Lion Park, including cub play.
