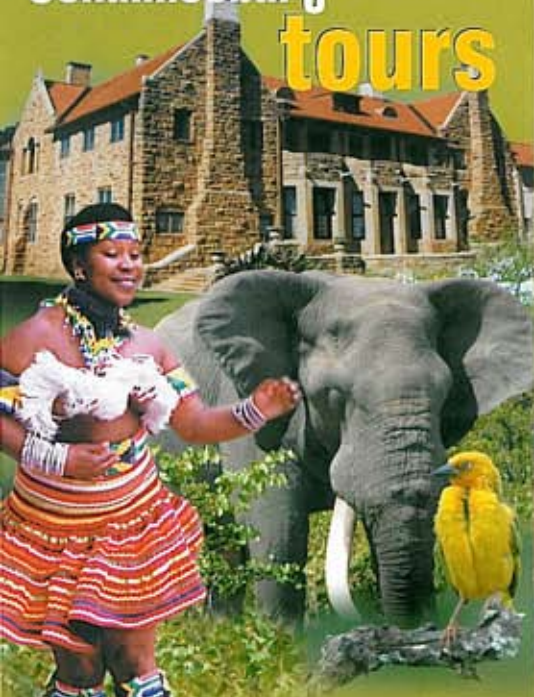

The Rhino and Lion Nature Reserve

This nature reserve lies on the outskirts of Johannesburg. Here visitors can view a variety of African wildlife including Buffalo, Rhino, Lion, Cheetah, Wild Dog, Zebra and Wildebeest.

The Cheetah Research Centre

The Cheetah is Africa's fastest cat and can reach speeds of up to 120 km/h over a very short distance. You will be taken on an educational tour of the King Cheetah's breeding program-me, where these exceptional creatures were rescued from extinction in South Africa. (only available on Tuesday / Thursday / Saturday / Sunday).

The Lion Park

More than 100 lions can be found in the Park with the rare white lion being the main attraction. The animals are viewed from our vehicles and there are excellent photographic opportunities. Different large African carnivore species are found, including hyenas, cheetahs and wild dogs. The Park's herbivore species include black wildebeest, springbok, blesbok, gemsbok, zebra and giraffe.

Crocodile Farm

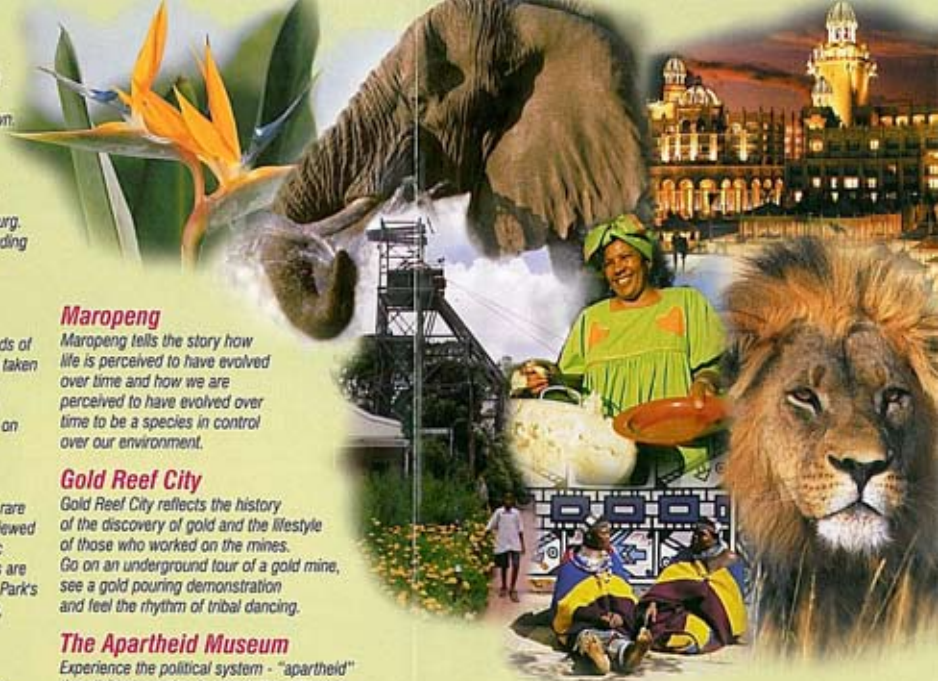
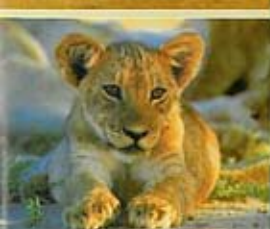
Observe one of the world's most spectacular predators at close range. On display are hatchlings to large adults of over four meters in length. Curios of local African craft as well as crocodile skin and meat products are sold from the curio shop.

Horse riding on a game farm

Gold Reef City

Gold Reef City reflects the history of the discovery of gold and the lifestyle of those who worked on the mines. Go on an underground tour of a gold mine, see a gold pouring demonstration and feel the rhythm of tribal dancing.

The Apartheid Museum

Experience the political system - "apartheid" that divided a nation for more than 48 years.

The Lesedi Cultural Village

Gauteng's most exciting showcase of African Culture where you can view four African villages. You will be introduced to the art, dancing, history and tribal legends of the African people.

The Cullinan Diamond Mine

Come and enjoy a underground or surface tour of a working diamond mine. The Cullinan Mine has produced some of the world's large high quality gemstones and is the home of the largest diamond in the world - the Cullinan Diamond (3106-ct).

The Sterkfontein Caves

Many Archeologists consider Sterkfontein as one of the world's most important anthropological sites. It is a World Heritage Site. It is here where Dr Robert Broom found the adult ape-man in 1936.

Underground Gemstone Mine tour

Colourful underground tour; passages of amethyst carpets, serene crystal, rose quartz chambers and tanzanite.

Constitution Hill

The site of Johannesburg's notorious Old Fort Prison Complex, where thousands of ordinary people were brutally punished before the dawn of democracy in 1994.
